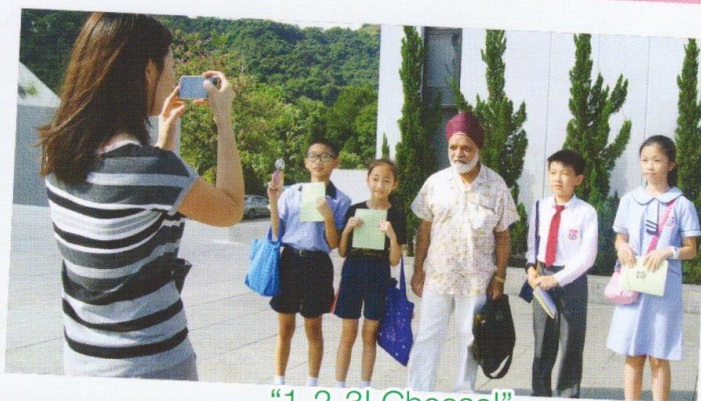

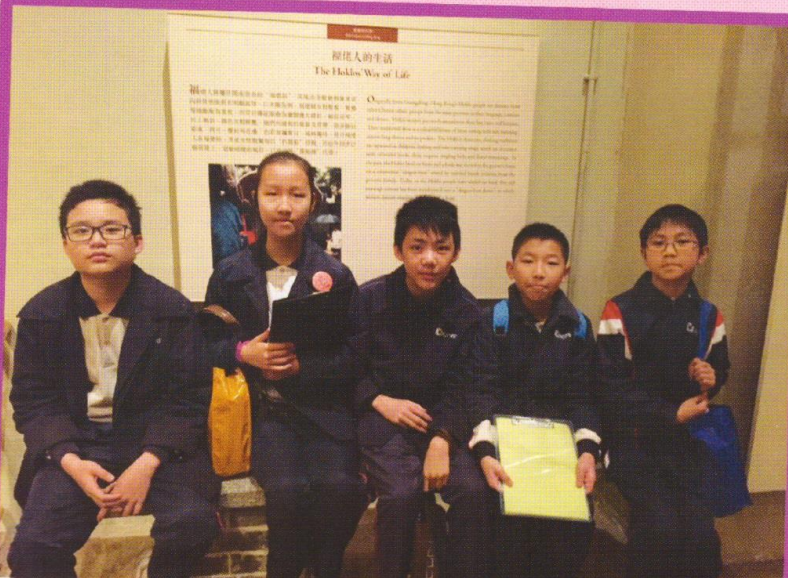

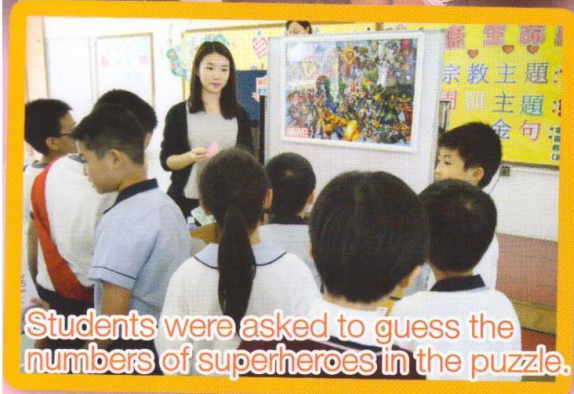
The 1st English Day was about favourite cartoon characters.

Each student was awarded a stamp for gifts after finishing the game.



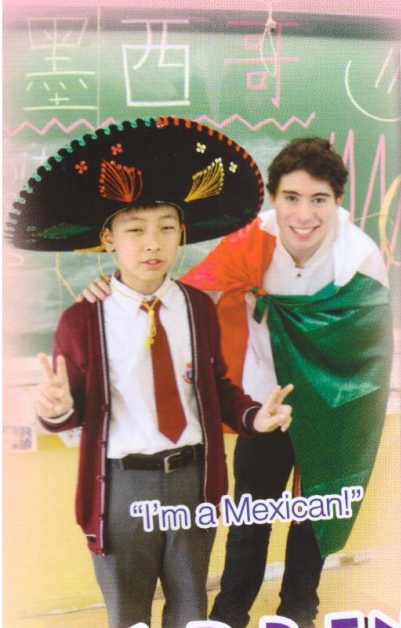
